We have been inundated with cats/kittens requiring medical care from IACS, Indy Neighborhood Cats and other organizations around the state. Plus, we have new hospice cases in our care. Without your support; we would not be able to be there for them..

We have cats who have had medical needs addressed or have birth defects or manageable health issues that are waiting for homes.

**Here are 2 that would love a home of their own. We do require 2 visits with any cat you may be interested in adopting.**

**Rhonda** is a lovely 10 yr old Flame point Siamese. She came from another shelter with a very injured eyelid. Surgery had to be done to take the dead tissue from the eyelid. With antibiotics, eye medications and surgery, the eyelid is healed. It will take time for all the fur to grow back. She also has no teeth, can eat dry food; does best with canned food. She would prefer a home with only one or two other cats. Perfect litter box habits

**Marmalade** is a lovely dark orange and white girl. Approx 5 to 7 years of age. She came from a rescue up north who thought she had been hit by a car. She actually has a birth defect that affects her walking and limits how high she can jump. Loves to be petted; would prefer to be an only cat, might do ok with one other house mate. Perfect with the litter box. I can email a copy of her spine/hip x ray to anyone or their vet, who is interested in adopting her.

We have adults and older kittens ready to have a home. Most have medical challenges.
