This has been the summer of kittens for us. Some have CH, birth defects, heart problems, came with mom cats with severe health problems and HBC kittens. Currently we have over 20 kittens; many special need, at the shelter house alone. We hope to get the adoptables into our adoption partner's program as they have space.

Thank you to all our readers and supporters who believe in Cats Haven and our mission.

As I had stated on the front we have been busy helping organizations with hoarding situations as we can. We can't/don't post pictures of the cats/kittens when we pull them. At times, the people that the cats were taken from will call rescues to see if the cats or kittens are there.

From 1 case we have taken in a 5week time frame; 9 kittens, a mom cat due to pop any day (was too far along to spay) and 4 mom cats that were finished nursing. Many of these cats and kittens are being fostered with vet techs due to their health issues.

The group of 9 tiny kittens were so malnourished, flea ridden, full of parasites and terribly ill with colds. Even after 6 weeks of care, many of them are still fragile health wise. The mom cats were in the same shape. The mom cats are now fully vetted.

We have adult cats who are ready for homes. Some require a knowledgeable home as they have challenges and we require 2 to 3 visits to help the possible owner see what care they need.

Thank you, for without your support we would not be able to help the cats and kittens who come our way.
